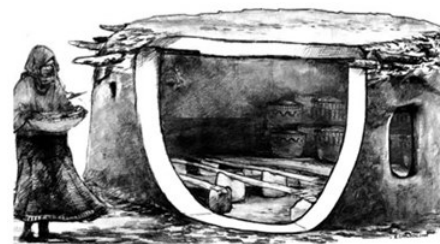

FINANCIAL UPDATE

Though we have (I hope!) been enjoying the beauty of summer and time recreating with family and friends, our gifts and offerings continue to reflect a faithful church. Our budgeted commitment to gifts and offerings for 2017 is \$90,000 per month from January-November. We budget for greater giving in December based on St. Paul's historical trend of even greater generosity during the Advent season. Our TOTAL income from gifts and offerings through June 30 is \$569,907.77. Our income currently is exceeding budgeted need by just over \$29,907. Based on expenses through June, we also presently have a net positive cash reserve. Thank you for sharing back with God abundantly through your service, gifts, worship, and witness. May the Lord continue to bless us so that we may be a blessing to others.
