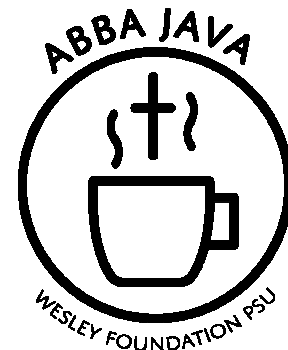

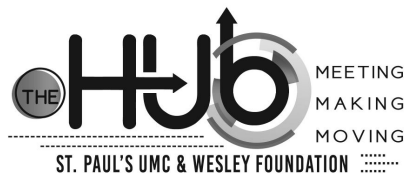
Stop by the tables at the Calder and College Ave doors today to sign up to help with Wesley Move-in hospitality.
