Praises

- Worship continues to grow as more children from the community join our choir and Sunday School.
- Urukundo School has 360 children, preschool - 3rd grade. 80 preschoolers will be added in 2016.
- Urukundo Children's Home kids excel in their education. Six are attending university.
- Five students graduated from the Sewing Tech Center. The top student earned a sewing machine.
- Several farm buildings lost their roofs but no animals were harmed. The roofs are being replaced.
- Over 600 layette kit items for new moms were made by many gifted hands that knit and sew.
- Partnerships with local schools, youth groups, scouts, churches and community organizations flourish.

New for 2016

- The mom and baby postnatal care outreach to vulnerable mothers continues to expand at the local birthing center, 2 hospitals and a refugee camp.
- Two 4th grade classrooms are complete so 57- 3rd graders can move up in January 2016.
- Two 5th grade classrooms and a latrine are being built for 2017.
- Youth groups and schools are raising \$1,500 for a water tank for the school and community
- 12-14 new students are accepted at our Sewing Tech Center
